

SUCCESS PROGRAM

Washington Middle School is offering an afterschool tutoring/study skills program. This program will focus on developing important study skills and organization skills, and students will also have the opportunity to receive help from a supervising teacher and trained peer tutors. Students should attend consistently and follow through with the habits at home to receive the full benefit of the program and develop study skills, organizational skills and set goals.

Students will be expected to bring their organization binder and all materials needed to work on assignments or study, and a book to read. Parents will be responsible for providing transportation home unless students are able to sign up for late transportation.

Times: Mondays and Thursdays from 3:20-5:15. (The Success Program will not run on early release days, Parent/Teacher conference days, when late transportation is not running or if there is inclement weather. If Success Tutoring is canceled without prior warning, students will be able to call home and an email will be sent to those parents who are in the Success Group email.)
