EARL REDMANN

Earl was an outstanding student, excelling in athletics and academics. He was also senior class president, graduating in 1949 from OFHS. After high school, he enrolled at Oshkosh State College transferring to the University of South Carolina after his sophomore year. He graduated with a BA degree in psychology from U.S.C. in 1953. He continued his education at U.S.C. completing his master's program in clinical psychology in 1955. Earl completed additional post graduate work at Ohio State University in business management.

In 1953, Earl married his high school sweetheart, Alyce Lemirande. Together, they had three children and had four grandchildren. His work took him and his family to many locations- South Carolina, Georgia, Ohio, and Maine.

In 1957, Earl began working for Union Camp Corporation, retiring in 1997 as general manager of corrugated box sales, marketing, and manufacturing divisions of Maine, New England, and eastern Canada. While with Union Camp, he worked with a company having worldwide operations in papermaking with 68 manufacturing facilities in 23 states, international operations in 24 countries, and more than 1.7 million acres of woodland properties.

Although retired, Earl continues to be active, doing consultation work for Union Camp. Most recently he was in China overseeing the start-up of operations there. He has also served on many boards including the Maine State Chamber of Commerce, Hospice of Mid-Coast Maine, Boy Scouts, and his church council. In 1992, Earl was honored by the State of Maine as "Businessman of the Year."
