Since that time, the 4K program has been growing and evolving in the Oconto Falls community.

Creative curriculum for the Four Year Old Kindergarten Program is based on Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards and Wisconsin DPI Standards for Common Core kindergarten. Students learn foundational academic skills through the Literacy Link program and the S.M.A.R.T. program. The Houghton-Mifflin Splash Into Pre-K reading series is also used to develop reading and math readiness skills. 4K The curriculum provides comprehensive exposure prerequisite skills to prepare students for success in kindergarten and throughout their educational careers.
